- Persons of any age (over 6 months) suffering from:
  - Chronic Respiratory Disease
  - Chronic Heart Disease
  - Chronic Liver Disease
  - Chronic Kidney Disease
  - Diabetes Mellitus
- Any Chronic Immunodeficiency State, including HIV/AIDS
- Pregnant Women
- Persons residing in institutions and Staff (Hospitals/homes for elderly, Homes for Disabled, CCF)
- Health Care Workers
- Children Aged 6 months to 59 months in Health Centre according to Health Centre NIS clinic Schedule (refer to slides that follow)









## ELIGIBILITY *for* Phase 1 & 2 Influenza vaccine



- Children aged 6 months to 59 months in Health Centre according to Health Centre NIS clinic Schedule (refer to slides that follow) and older children who fall in chronic disease list (as per Adults)
  - Chronic Respiratory Disease
  - Chronic Heart Disease
  - Chronic Liver Disease
  - Chronic Kidney Disease
  - Diabetes Mellitus
- Any Chronic Immunodeficiency State, including HIV/AIDS
- Pregnant Women
- Persons residing in institutions and Staff (Hospitals/homes for elderly, Homes for Disabled, CCF)
- Health Care Workers
- Children Aged 6 months to 59 months in Health Centre according to Health Centre NIS clinic Schedule (refer to slides that follow)

- Persons residing in institutions and Staff (Hospitals/homes for elderly, Homes for Disabled, CCF)
- Health Care Workers
