

## Guidelines to set up a Breastfeeding Room at the place of work

## **Essential requirements:**

- 1. Minimal space is needed to set up a breastfeeding room (e.g. a vacant office, a storeroom or an unused room). Room dimensions, at least 6 feet x 6 feet. The breastfeeding room needs to be made as attractive as possible
- 2. International Breastfeeding Logo affixed to the door of the Breastfeeding Room (Logo stickers can be obtained from the Health Promotion and Disease Prevention Directorate, tel: 23266000)
- 3. The Breastfeeding Room must:
  - o Have locks indicating that the room is occupied from the inside.
  - o Be kept meticulously clean at all times
  - o Have a refrigerator and kept in good working order at all times.
  - o Electrical outlets (Maltese standard 230 Volts)
  - o Comfortable chairs
  - A table or shelf/flat surface to hold the breast pump and milk container
  - Sink with hot and cold water supply, liquid soap and disposable paper towels, to wash and dry hands
  - o Marker to label the milk bags with the expressed breast milk
- 4. Employee/breastfeeding mother brings her own manual or electric breast pump

It is recommended that a logbook is kept to record the number of mothers visiting this room – for statistical purposes.

## **Additional requirements:**

- 1. Disinfectant wipes.
- 2. Water dispenser.
